



## Healthcare Analytics Certificate

*Are you a healthcare professional who is ready to sharpen your analytical skills? The healthcare analytics certificate is the solution you've been seeking. This 4-course certificate can be completed in 4 months and equips you with introductory skills and analytical tools that you can immediately apply to your work to effectively analyze healthcare data using Excel, improve data visualization techniques, and make better decisions to improve quality and performance. This certificate is geared towards healthcare professionals in the following areas: clinical, non-clinical and leadership. The certificate includes the opportunity to earn an industry-recognized certification, Microsoft Office Specialist (MOS) Excel Certification*

### GENERAL INFORMATION

1. You must submit a CE Registration Request on our website to register for this course. Your request will then be processed, and you will receive a confirmation email with payment instructions. Registration is complete once payment is received.
2. The Healthcare Analytics program is a certificate comprising of four courses. The recommended course progression is HITT 1070: Introduction to Health Analytics and ITSW 1070: Introduction to Excel (taken simultaneously). Once these first two courses are complete, students may begin ITSW 1071: Introduction to Analytics with Excel. Upon successful completion of the third course, students may take INTW 1073: Data Visualization.

#### 3. Financial Aid

*The Healthcare Analytics certificate is not eligible for Pell Grants or student loans; however, other funding sources are available to assist students pay for these courses.*

- FAFSA: The Texas Public Education Grant (TPEG) is a grant designed to help Texas resident students cover his/her tuition and fees, when these expenses exceed the Expected Family Contribution (EFC) reported on their Student Aid Report (SAR). TPEG is awarded to eligible applicants on a first-come, first-served basis while funds are available and does not cover the cost of books, material, tools or any other supplies. To determine eligibility for TPEG, you will need to submit a FAFSA to Navarro College.
